

Memorial Community Hospital and Health System (MCH) is committed to meeting the needs of our patients and has a financial assistance program available for patients unable to pay the cost of their medical care.

- Patients who submit a completed application documenting that they are at or below the 40th percentile of household income for the Omaha MSA are eligible for assistance. Required documents include: a completed MCH financial assistance application, current pay stubs, current bank statement, and the prior year's tax return.
- Assistance offered is in the form of a reduction of the amount due. This reduction ranges from 50%-100% and is based on income guidelines.
- Financial assistance applications are available at MCH at all points of entry, the MCH Financial Counselors office located at Memorial Community Hospital, 810 N 22nd St, Blair, Nebraska and on the website at www.mchhs.org.
- The MCH Patient Financial Services Department is available to assist you with any questions as well as filing out the application if needed. They are available Monday-Friday from 7:30am-4:30pm and can be reached by calling 402-426-1255.

- No patient who qualifies for financial assistance will be charged more than amounts generally billed for emergency and other medically necessary care.
